David's Preparations for the Temple — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

1. Why was David not permitted to build the Temple himself, according to 1 Chronicles 22:8?

Because he had shed much blood and fought great wars.

2. Who does God say will build the Temple instead (1 Chronicles 22:9-10)?

David's son (Solomon), a man of rest and peace.

3. What promise is repeated here about Solomon's throne (1 Chronicles 22:10)?

That God would establish the throne of his kingdom over Israel forever.

4. What did David do to help, even though he wouldn't build the Temple himself (summarise from surrounding chapters)?

He gathered materials, resources, and made extensive preparations so Solomon could build it.

5. Reflection: David contributed to something he wouldn't live to see completed. Is there a project or cause you support even without expecting to see its full outcome?

Open, personal reflection.
