

Malachi — Worksheet 1: Answer Key

Robbing God — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

1. What accusation does God bring in Malachi 3:8?

That the people have robbed Him, in tithes and offerings.

2. What instruction is given in Malachi 3:10?

To bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, so there would be food in God's house.

3. What does God invite the people to do, unusually, in that same verse?

'Prove me now herewith' — to test Him, and see if He would not pour out blessing beyond what they could contain.

4. Reflection: What do you make of God inviting His people to 'test' Him regarding generosity, when testing God is discouraged elsewhere in Scripture?

Open reflection — look for engagement with the specific, unique nature of this invitation regarding generosity and trust.
