1. What is the well-known statement in Zechariah 4:6?

'Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts.'

2. What obstacle is described as a 'great mountain' in Zechariah 4:7?

Whatever stood in the way of Zerubbabel completing the Temple's rebuilding — it would become a plain before him.

3. What is promised will happen to the finished building, according to the rest of verse 7?

He would bring forth the headstone (capstone) with shouts of 'Grace, grace unto it.'

4. Reflection: 'Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit' is a well-known verse for facing overwhelming tasks. Is there a 'mountain' in your life you're trying to move through your own strength rather than relying on God?
