The King Comes Riding on a Donkey

Read the passages on the back of this sheet (or use the biblestudy.fyi TTS Bible Player) before you begin. Answer in your own words on the lines provided.

1. What instruction is given to 'the daughter of Zion' in Zechariah 9:9?

2. How is this coming king described in the same verse?

3. What will this king do, according to Zechariah 9:10?

4. Why is this passage especially significant for the Gospels' account of Palm Sunday?

5. Reflection: This king is described as lowly and riding a donkey, not a war horse. What does that detail suggest about the nature of His kingdom?

Scripture for Zechariah — The King Comes Riding on a Donkey

Zechariah 9:9-10

⁹Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass. ¹⁰And I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim, and the horse from Jerusalem, and the battle bow shall be cut off: and he shall speak peace unto the heathen: and his dominion shall be from sea even to sea, and from the river even to the ends of the earth.
